

Did You Know...

that Historic Elmwood Cemetery is the resting place of E. Cora Hind (1861-1942), teacher, feminist, journalist. She became the first female journalist in Western Canada and first published in the Manitoba Free Press, where she became western correspondent for Eastern newspapers and a noted journalist for the Manitoba Free Press famed across the country for her crop estimates, which usually contained less than 1% margin of error... She died in Winnipeg, October 6th, 1942 at the age of 81.
